Trinity Council Minutes February 10, 2016

President Tom Dodge called the meeting to order.

The Secretary's report from January 13th was read and there were no changes.

Clayton presented the Treasurer's report. There is \$14,796 in checking and \$71,445 in savings. The heat fund is part of the savings and is at \$34,150.

Stewardship: Duane reported that there was nothing new to report at this time. It was decided to donate the food that has been collected at the church to a family in need in our congregation rather than the Salvation Army. Duane and his committee will be looking into this.

Lay Ministry: Yvonne reported that she had a talk with Pastor

Krista and that Trinity Truman would host a coffee Party for Krista on her 1st anniversary. We will be inviting Synod members to this gathering also. Pastor Krista said she already feels part of our congregation. She also stated that if at any time someone needed to reach her to please call her cell phone. If she needs to leave the church for any reason during her office hours here, she will put a note on the door with estimated time of return.

Church Properties: It was noted that Brad did check in at the church after the power outage to be sure everything was okay.

Christian Ed: Nikki reported that we have about 25 students that should be attending Sunday school but on an average very few attend. It is hoped that when the weather is better this number will increase. Parents are reminded to please see that your child attends on a regular basis.

Youth: Teressa reported that they had received \$250 from Thrivent to help with the Lenten service suppers. The Suppers will be Feb. 17th, March 2nd and March 16th at 5:30 before the worship service at 7pm.

Worship: Cathy reported that sheets with the names of communion servers and readers for worship services are being formed. It was also noted that Calvin from Madelia

needs to be paid for his help with the worship service.

OLD BUSINESS: It was decided to pay The Sentinel \$35 for advertisement of Easter Service.

NEW BUSINESS: Peterson Anthony sent a letter about wanting to quote us insurance prices again. It will be turned over to Brad and his committee.

There was a discussion on doing a fund raiser for Madelia business's that were lost in the fire. Yvonne made a motion to send \$1000 from the Christmas fund to S. MN Initiative Foundation to help Madelia rebuild. Motion passed.

WELCA NEWS

The quarterly WELCA meeting was held on February 8. Co-President Barb Shoen called the meeting to order. Co President Barb Mager gave devotions. The secretary's report was read by Connie Selnes. She also read many thank you notes from organizations who had received monetary gifts from our WELCA group.

Committee reports followed. Information about up-coming donations for school kits, personal care kits, baby care kits and fabric kits that can be put together and brought to the spring WELCA meeting at East Svedahl church near St. James.

These kits will then be bundled up and distributed across the globe to needy families. It was suggested that all of our church members could help bring supplies that can be used to make any of these kits. **Please check out the following list on page 6 and see if you can bring any of these items.** There will be boxes in the quilting room where these supplies can be stored until the kits are put together. The supplies need to be at church by the end of March.

The lists are organized so that you can clip it apart on the lines

and stick them in your wallet. They take up as much room that way as a dollar bill, and you could pull them out of your wallet when you are shopping and see what supplies you could buy from the lists.

Fleece Blankets that are 60" x 80" require 2 1/2 yards of two different colors/designs of fleece fabric for each quilt. These quilts will be set up around church for anyone to help tie the fringes. These quilts will also be given to Lutheran World Relief. If you can donate fleece fabric, please bring it to the quilt room.

It was decided that the money that is received from the sale of recycled greeting cards should again go toward the Truman mini-golf course development project. Cards for all occasions are always on sale for 50 cents each. Look through the box that is on the table on the church entrance table or check out the box that is located at Truman Flowers and Gifts. Last year over \$450.00 was donated to the mini-golf course project. Each sale counts up, and the cards are a good value.

Confirmation stoles will be made for the two Trinity confirmands who will be confirmed on May 15. Quilts for Trinity youth who will be graduating this year will be completed and presented to the seniors and foreign exchange students at the May 22 church service.

Chair persons are needed for the annual Salad Luncheon on June 29 and the Cookie Walk on December 3. Please let Barb Shoen know if you are willing to help organize these great money-making and community friendly projects.

A number of years ago we were discussing what went into a particular Lutheran World Relief kit at circle and my Aunt pulled a list from her purse – she carried it with her while shopping. These are the items for the new LWR kits. Copy the new lists, share them, clip them and take them with you. This is the size of a dollar bill. God bless you as you serve our Heavenly King by serving those in need.

Personal Care Kits

- ✚ One light- or medium-weight bath-size towel (approximately 52" X 27"), dark color recommended.
- ✚ Two bath-size bars (4 to 5 oz.) of soap, any brand, in original wrapping
- ✚ One Adult-size toothbrush in its original packaging*
- ✚ One sturdy comb, remove packaging
- ✚ One metal nail clippers, remove packaging

*Toothbrush multi-packs may be used by sealing an individual toothbrush in a business-size envelope; no plastic bags.

School Kits

- ✚ Four 70-sheet notebooks of wide- or college-ruled paper approximately 8" X 10 ½"; no loose-leaf paper
 - ✚ One 30-centimeter ruler, or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other
 - ✚ One pencil sharpener
 - ✚ One 2 ½ inch eraser
 - ✚ One blunt scissors (safety scissors with embedded steel blades work well)
 - ✚ Five unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers; secure together with a rubber band
 - ✚ Five ballpoint pens (no gel ink); secure together with a rubber band
 - ✚ One box of 16 or 24 crayons
- One sturdy drawstring backpack-style cloth bag

Baby Care Kits

- ✚ Two lightweight cotton t-shirts
- ✚ Two long- or short-sleeved gowns or sleepers (without feet)
- ✚ Two receiving blankets, medium-weight cotton or flannel, or crocheted or knitted with lightweight yarn, up to 52" square
- ✚ Four cloth diapers, flat fold preferred
- ✚ One jacket, sweater or sweatshirt with a hood or include a baby cap
- ✚ Two pairs of socks
- ✚ One hand towel, dark color recommended
- ✚ Two bath-size bars (4 to 5 oz.) of gentle soap, in original wrapping
- ✚ Two diaper pins or large safety pins

Fabric Kits

- ✚ Two pieces of cotton or cotton-blend fabric (no knits or 100% polyester); fabric should have no stains or holes and be cut into pieces measuring:
 - 2 ¼ yards of 60" wide fabric, or
 - 3 yards of 44" wide fabric, or
 - 4 yards of 36" wide fabric
- ✚ Two spools of matching or neutral colored general purpose thread, 250-300 yards each

Ewer and basin

The ewer (a vase-shaped pitcher) and basin, which symbolize cleansing, are related to two biblical events from Holy Week: when Jesus washed his disciples' feet (John 13:1-17), and when Pilate "washed his hands of" Jesus' blood before the crucifixion (Matthew 27:24). Because of the foot-washing, the ewer and basin have become a symbol of service ministry.
