We are entering a two month holiday season in the church - All Saints Sunday,

Christ the King Sunday, Thanksgiving, Advent and Christmas.

I especially want to invite you to join us for the four Sundays of Advent (starting November 30th) as we prepare for Christmas. We will be following the theme "A Grand Miracle" which points to the saving, life-changing aspects of Christ's birth using quotes from C. S. Lewis, author of The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe. 
