The old sound system is from 1989 and is need of replacing. Other contacts were made with for quotes. One company did not reply, and one company wanted payment for travel to make a bid on new system. Bruce Oritz total cost for bid received is \$11,361.42 for the main portion of upgrade and sanctuary.

There will be additional costs for upgrade in the kitchen area of the church of about \$647. Warranty is 5 years on parts and 1 year on labor. Cathy Sorenson said there is money in differ-

ent church accounts that can be used for this upgrade with no needed fund raising for this project.

Don Wilkening motioned to go forward with the purchase of the new sound system as well as the kitchen upgrade system. Sandy Meyer second. Motion passed.

Use simple ingredients and your imagination to bake these fluffy, cloud-like treats.

## What you need:

- 3 egg whites
- ½ tsp. vanilla extract
- Mixer
- 2 Tbsp. powdered sugar
- 1 Tbsp. cornstarch
- Parchment paper

#### What you do:

- 1. Preheat oven to 300°. In a mixing bowl, combine egg whites and vanilla. Whisk eggs with mixer at medium speed until frothy.
- 2. While whisking, gradually add sugar and cornstarch. Keep whisking at high speed until stiff peaks form.
- 3. Spoon mixture onto a baking sheet lined with parchment paper. Create fun shapes.
- 4. Bake 20 minutes. Cool and enjoy!


