

- 4. When you fill an entire row, draw a smiley face in the DAY 7 square. The first player with two smileys wins.


# +Christian Symbol+

#### Chalice & Cross

The chalice with a cross rising from it symbolizes Christ's obedient suffering, even unto death. The cross is called a "passion cross," with pointed ends that represent suffering. We remember that in the garden of Gethsemane, Jesus begged his Father that the "cup" of suffering be taken from him. But ultimately, he prayed, "Not as I will, but as you will" (Matthew 26:39, NIV).

At this time of year, God's creation "springs" to life.


Directions: After reading Genesis 1:1–2:3, write the correct Creation day number under each picture. Then add up each day's total and write it on the correct blank below.
