Pastor Krista--We have received a scholarship to send at least 4 people to the Cultivating Generous Congregations program in Marshall. The dates are September 28, November 2 and January 11. Anyone interested in going should talk to Pastor Krista or Grant. Pastor will be gone 2 Sundays in August and Karen Koeder and Rebecca Sullivan will fill in for her. There was discussion about standing during the worship service and Pastor will be making some adjustments. Pastor was given permission to switch service times on God's Work, Our Hands Day on September 8. We will have a short service at 8:45.

WELCA NEWS

Our salad luncheon was again successful venture. One hundred twenty seven people were served and there were ten take-outs. Seventy three families either brought salads or other food, or contributed money. We thank everyone who helped in any way and especially Arlene and Sandy, the chairmen. The profit was \$1,607 which will be added to the roof fund.

Yvonne and Lowell Noorlun have agreed to keep oil in the candles. We thank them for agreeing to do that.

We once again are doing the school kits. There is such a need for them because there are countries where the people are so poor they cannot even purchase school supplies for their children. Without supplies the children are not allowed to go to school. Each school kit we make includes:

- Four 70 sheet notebook either wide or college ruled paper
- A twelve inch ruler with both inches & centimeters
- One pencil sharpener
- One blunt scissors
- Five no. 2 pencils with erasers, secured with a rubber band
- One box of crayons, 16 or 24 count only

We encourage anybody who is able to purchase enough for a complete kit or buy several of any of the items that are needed.

This can be done by anyone, not just the ten or fifteen members that attend the WELCA meetings.

Needed: Volunteers to chair the cookie walk, our only other fund raiser. It should be fairly easy because of the good records that have been kept and also all the good help for the event.

A letter was read from Jeff Marquart representing the Child Safety and Drug Prevention Program. It was decided that we send \$300 from the designated Lenten funds to support this county wide program. The money will be used to distribute materials to students in the county.

The organ has some keys that are sticking. The worship committee is working on getting the organ repaired. Motion carried that \$500 be allowed to fix the organ.

September 8 is God's Work, Our Hands Sunday. Yvonne will be working to organize the Ronald McDonald project. Arlene and Cathy will organize the areas in town that need some work. Jan volunteered to organize the lunch. Help is welcome from everyone. Pastor is still looking for volunteers to go to the Cultivating Generous Congregations workshops. 
