 - 3. Advocate regular offerings at unit events.
 - 4. Transmit offerings regularly to Women of the ELCA.

Trinity WELCA Policies

1. We buy kitchen equipment out of general funds.
2. We make quarterly payments to WELCA, 25% of the offerings at our business meetings and the Tuesday morning Bible Study.
3. We give memorials for our members in the following manner: \$10.00 for spouse or child, \$5.00 for parent, grandchild or sibling. Memorial money goes to Trinity Gifts & Memorials Fund.
4. **We do not allow any equipment to be taken from the kitchen.**
5. We furnish money for confirmation stoles.
6. We pay .54 cents per mile for WELCA delegates to conventions and workshops. We also pay for meals for officers who attend workshops.
7. We furnish new members with *The Lutheran Woman Today* at no charge for one year.
8. We furnish towels for baptism.
9. We donate \$110.00 to the LMH Auxiliary to be paid in January
10. WELCA pays transportation costs for shipping quilts.
11. We pay for holiday gifts for our Trinity shut-ins.
12. We request donations of \$50.00 or more to the WELCA at events such as anniversaries.
13. We will pay up to \$50.00 per year, plus mileage for guest speakers.
14. Lace tablecloths may be used only in church by church members. There will be a small fee for laundering.
15. We pay \$100.00 for entertainment and cake for LMH birthday parties.
16. We give a quilt to new members.
