- 13. We pay for holiday gifts for our Trinity members in nursing Homes, in the Lutheran Manor and anyone over 90 years.

Working Division Responsibilities

Working divisions have the following responsibilities delegated by the WELCA executive board:

for the round tables in the west storeroom in the balcony. Lace tablecloths may be used only in the church by members for church functions. There will be a small charge for laundering.

A punch bowl is located in the top cupboard of the broom closet in the kitchen.
